Wider objectives of the project	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- To re-examine the relationship between applied linguistics and language pedagogy.</li> <li>- To train students and future teachers in foreign languages in the way they are actually spoken in authentic situations, as opposed to a prescriptive grammar-based approach to language pedagogy.</li> </ul>
Specific project objectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- To provide language students with practical resources in the foreign language matched to the student's capabilities, interests and needs.</li> <li>- To contextualize these sources and allow opportunities for students to respond to the materials, promoting meaningful communication in the target language.</li> <li>- For students develop a real awareness of the language as a way of self-expression, instead of simply processing the language</li> </ul>

Outputs and Outcomes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The methodology uses an individual-focused approach. Our approach is constructivist, in that the student must construct his/her learning in a way in which he/she occupies the main role as an active student. He/she must construct his/her own learning as an active student who searches, chooses, classifies, and evaluates problems in arriving at a linguistic solution.</li> </ul>
Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Approach language as a communicative tool first and foremost. We put students in authentic situations of language use, such as in restaurants, markets, cafés, etc.,</li> <li>- Engage students in workshops on special topics, such as the literature, poetry, and pop culture of the target language, as well as discussions of current events to stimulate participation.</li> </ul>
