It then developed many ground breaking services including</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the first specialist project solely for mentally ill rough sleepers, funded by the Government • the first specialist project solely for rough sleepers who drink heavily • the only specialist project solely for elderly rough sleepers and, more recently • the first Recovery College in the homelessness sector. <p>Broadway was created on 1 April 2002 from the merger of two London charities that, between them, had been supporting homeless people for more than 20 years.</p> <p>St Mungo's Broadway was formed in April 2014 by the merger of two well established, respected homelessness charities; St Mungo's and Broadway.</p>

Other	<p>St Mungo’s Broadway provides services and temporary accommodation for homeless vulnerable adults:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - outreach services - assessment centres - first stage, complex needs hostels (24/7 support) - specialist, complex needs hostels (24/7 support) - semi supported housing - floating support - skills and employment services - prisons <p>Our clients have generally been multiply excluded and we work to support clients around issues such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - drugs and alcohol use - domestic violence - abuse - physical and mental health - immigration, asylum - welfare benefits - street sex working - family breakdown, children in care - ex-offenders, probation, court work <p>As a student you will have the opportunity to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - work within a dedicated, supportive team with an onsite supervisor - visit/shadow other teams within the organization - visit/shadow services/agencies working in the locality - work from a Recovery Perspective - work in a multi professional and agency manner - accompany clients to appointments (eg health, court, etc) - advocate for clients and support clients to self advocate - work on a 1 to 1 basis with clients - facilitate group activities, run workshops - attend training (e-learning and face to face) - attend monthly group reflective practice - practice and develop social work theories, models and tools
